

Getting Started

Proper labelling and packaging of batteries is extremely important when shipping via mail.

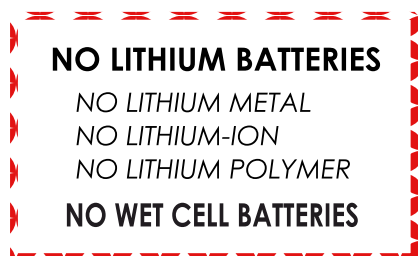
Batteries containing lithium must follow specific regulations to which this return kit does not conform. **DO NOT INCLUDE LITHIUM** in a Dry Cell Battery Recycling Kit.

Tape the terminals of any batteries over 9V using **CLEAR TAPE ONLY**.

Acceptable Batteries

- Alkaline
- Nickel Cadmium / Nickel Metal Hydride
- Zinc Air or Zinc Carbon
- Non-lithium Button Cell
- Sealed Lead Acid*

**Attach "NONSPILLABLE BATTERY" label*



Certificates of Recycling

Collection and Packaging of Used Batteries

- Fill out the GENERATOR and ACCUMULATION START DATE information on the date you start collection.
- Fill the pail with batteries. Be sure to follow terminal taping instructions below.
- Once collection is complete, securely attach the lid to the pail.
- Return pail to original shipping box (if possible) or ship directly in pail if no additional boxes are provided.
- Attach all necessary labels:
 - ★ UPS Return Shipping (may already be attached to pail)
 - ★ "This Side Up" (only necessary if shipping in box)
 - ★ "NONSPILLABLE BATTERY" (if returning Lead Acid batteries)

Taping Battery Terminals

Using **CLEAR TAPE ONLY** or a clear poly liner, cover the terminals completely so that it is impossible for adjacent battery terminals to interact. The included poly liner is used to lessen shifting during transit and is not a substitute for proper taping of terminals that require it.

- Most household batteries do not need terminals taped.
- Tape the terminals or enclose the battery if OVER 9V.
- Tape the terminals of ALL Lead Acid Batteries.
